COURSE INFORMATION

The Qualifications in Early Childhood Education and Care have been designed to provide students with the opportunity to learn and practice the fundamental knowledge and skills required to work within the early childhood education sector.

We aim to equip our graduates with the necessary skills and knowledge to enable them to successfully satisfy the demands of the workplace.

The Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121) will provide you with the knowledge and skills required to use organisation policies, procedures and individual children's profiles to plan activities and provide care to children, facilitating their leisure and play and enabling them to achieve their developmental outcomes. The Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC50121) qualification reflects the role of Early Childhood Educators who are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum in Early Childhood Education and Care services. In doing so they work to implement an approved learning framework within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standards.

Students who achieved CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care could progress to the CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. Please contact the College for more information.

COURSE DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT METHODS

Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121)

The program is delivered over 594 hours face to face for 36 college weeks, 36 hours online learning for 9 college weeks and work placement of 6 hours per week for 27 college weeks.

Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC50121)

The program is delivered over 576 hours face to face for 36 college weeks and work placement of 8 hours per week for 36 college weeks.

Assessment methodology may include but is not limited to question and answer, case studies, work placement tasks, project, skills based log, third party evidence, and observational assessment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Year 11 or equivalent certificate of senior secondary education.

Recommended English Level: IELTS 6.0 (with no individual band less than 5.0) or equivalent. (If the level of English is insufficient, a suitable course can be organised).

With direct entry to the CHC50121 Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care, the duration is 1 year (4 terms).

These qualifications are recognised by the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF), meaning that you can take this qualification anywhere within Australia.

WORK PLACEMENT

Work Placement is required to receive the award for Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121) and Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC50121). We assist in securing a work placement for you and assist in the organisation of the workplace learning and associated workplace activities. The work placement is unpaid and the daily working hours will be negotiated between students and early childhood education and care service. Our trainers will visit each centre during the work placement to assess student performance as part of the assessment of the practical components of the course.
