### **COURSE INFORMATION**

Australian International High School (AIHS) is registered by the New South Wales Education Standards Authority (NESA) offering Years 11 and 12 to international and local students. We are also accredited to present candidates for the Higher School Certificate (HSC).

### COURSE

Years 11 & 12 (Combined 2-year Course) are delivered face-toface.

### ASSESSMENT METHODS

Assessment methodology may include but is not limited to: project/report, written/oral tasks inlcuding multiple choice, question and answer, essays and presentations.

### PATHWAYS

Depending upon course completion and subject grades, students may go on to university or enrol in a VET (vocational education and training) Certificate, Diploma or Advanced Diploma course at an Academies Australasia College. Students may also go to university after completing a VET course.

The VET colleges in the Academies Australasia Group have pathway arrangements with many universities and institutions of higher learning.

### RESOURCES AND FACILITIES

We offer modern facilities, including audio-visual equipment and internet access. Being in the centre of the Sydney CBD, we are very well served by public transport and are close to public libraries. The student lounge is well equipped (microwave ovens, vending machines, computers with (free) internet access). Classes are held at Level 6, 505 George Street, Sydney NSW Australia.
