The Qualifications in Early Childhood Education and Care have been designed to provide students with the opportunity to learn and practice the fundamental knowledge and skills required to work within the early childhood education sector.

We aim to equip our graduates with the necessary skills and knowledge to enable them to successfully satisfy the demands of the workplace.

The Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121) will provide you with the knowledge and skills required to use organisation policies, procedures and individual children's profiles to plan activities and provide care to children, facilitating their leisure and play and enabling them to achieve their developmental outcomes. The Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC50121) qualification reflects the role of Early Childhood Educators who are responsible for designing and implementing curriculum in Early Childhood Education and Care services. In doing so they work to implement an approved learning framework within the requirements of the Education and Care Services National Regulations and the National Quality Standards.

Students who achieved CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care could progress to the CHC50121 Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care. Please contact the College for more information.

COURSE DELIVERY & ASSESSMENT METHODS

Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC30121)

This program is delivered over 36 college weeks across four terms. During the first three terms, students attend two days of face-to-face theory classes and complete four hours of online study each week. In the final term, students participate in work placement, with a minimum of 160 hours of practical experience required to successfully complete the program.

Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC50121)

The Diploma program is also delivered over 36 college weeks, divided into four terms. For the first three terms, students attend two days of face-to-face theory classes and complete four hours of online study per week. The final term focuses on work placement, requiring a minimum of 280 hours of practical experience to meet the program requirements.

ACADEMIC YEAR / START DATES

Don't miss out on your intake dates. There are 36 teaching weeks per annum with the year being divided into 4 terms of 9 weeks each. The academic year begins in January and ends November. Primary intakes are at the beginning of each term.

Entry to Diploma

To enrol in the Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care (CHC50121), a student must have completed either the CHC30121 or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care. With direct entry, a student can achieve Diploma in just 1 year (4 terms).

Work Placement

The College may aid in securing work placement which is required for both the Certificate III and the Diploma. Work placements are typically unpaid, with working hours negotiated between the student and the early education service provider. Work placement visits will be conducted by our trainers (within an agreed distance) to assess student's practical skills as part of the course requirements.

First Aid Requirements

Some workplace institutions may require completion of additional First Aid units before a student can commence work placement. The HLTAID012 unit is included in the Certificate III course. We also offer the following First Aid units for a fee of \$75:

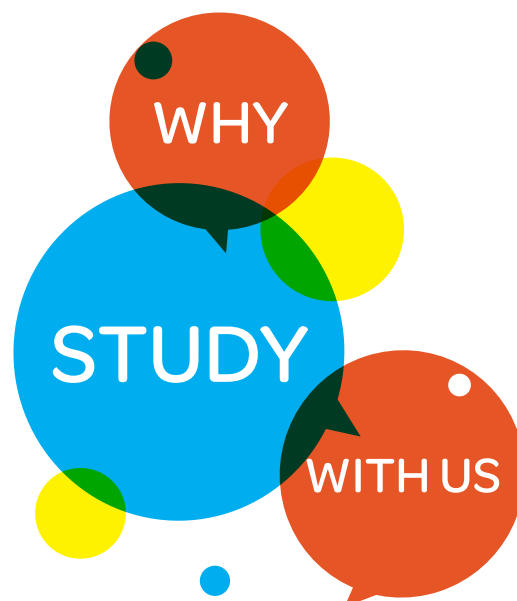
- HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- HLTAID010 - Provide basic emergency life support
- HLTAID011 - Provide First Aid

Students who complete these additional units will receive a **separate Statement of Attainment**. Alternatively, students may opt to obtain First Aid certification from other providers.
